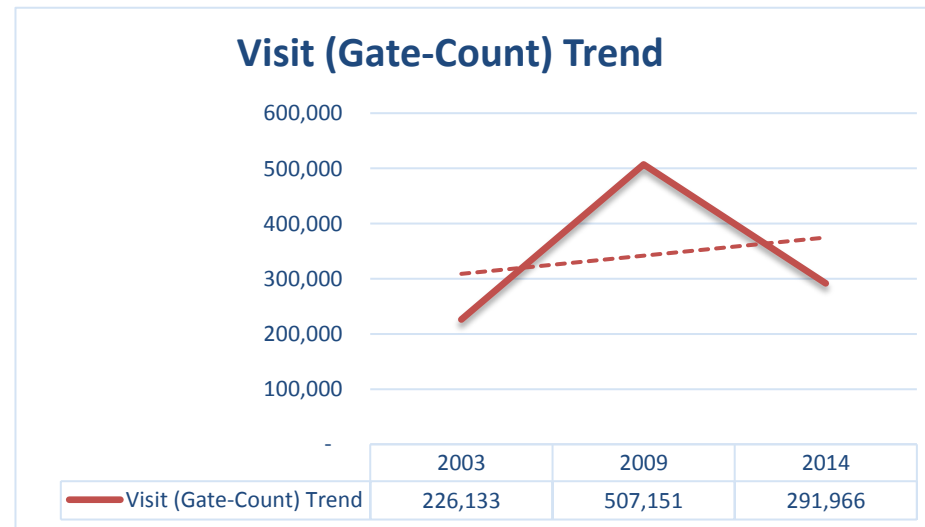
Circulation Trend

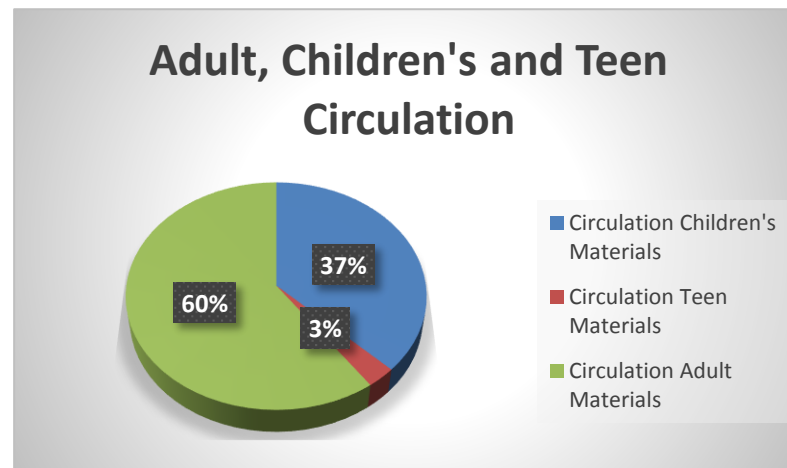
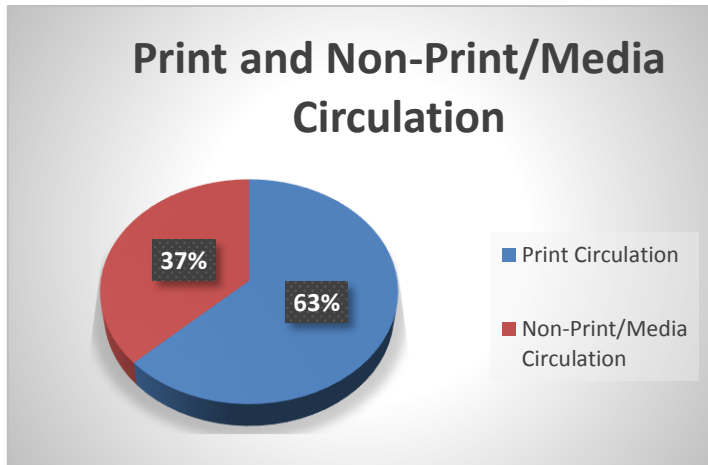
