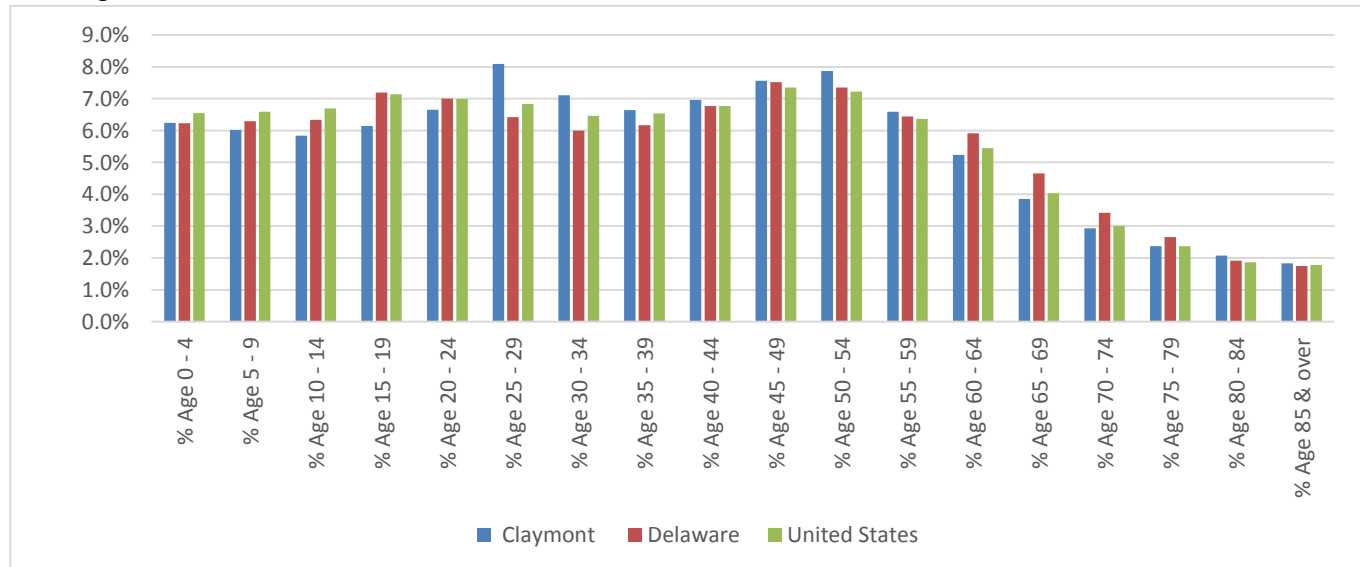

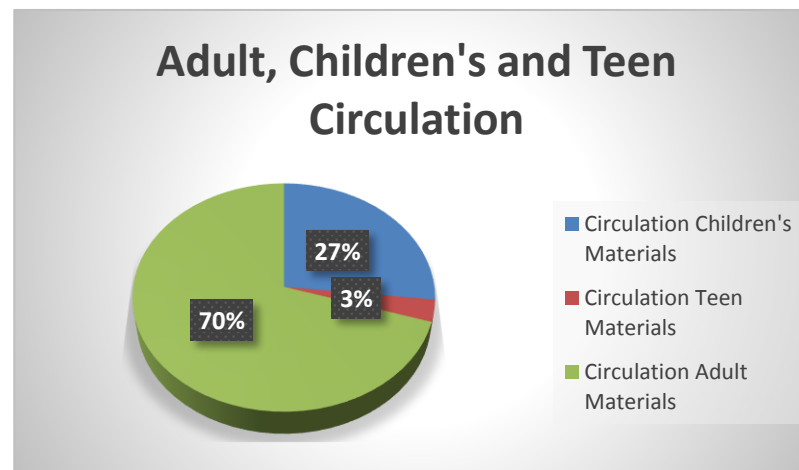
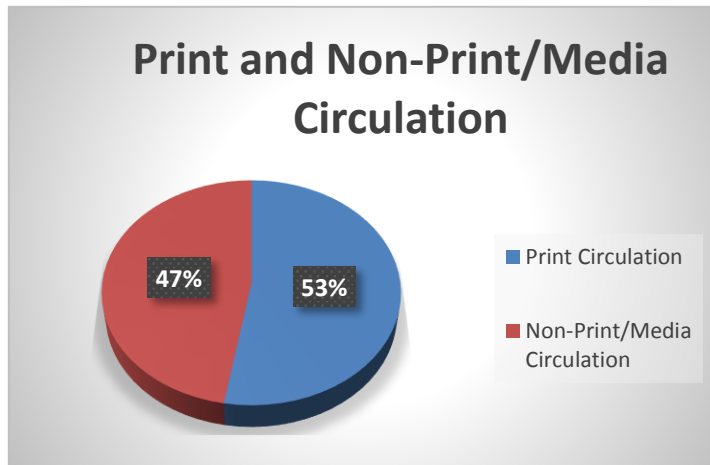


Visit (Gate-Count) Trend
