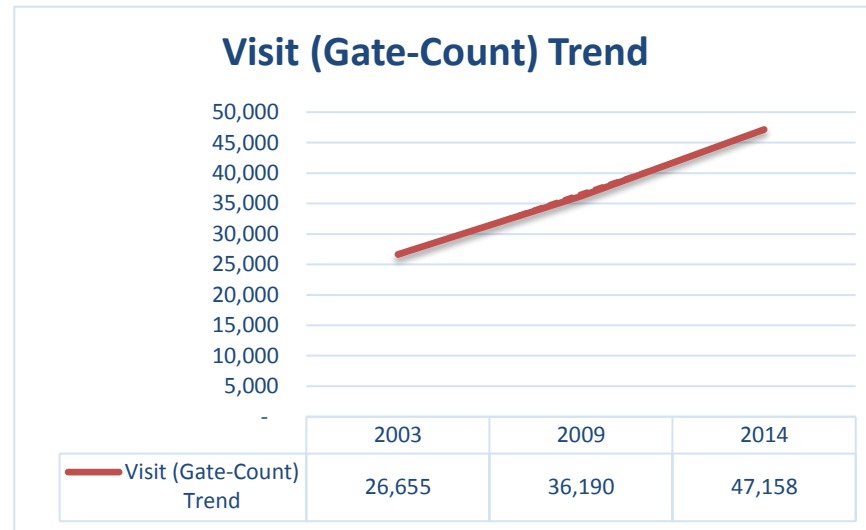
### Circulation Trend

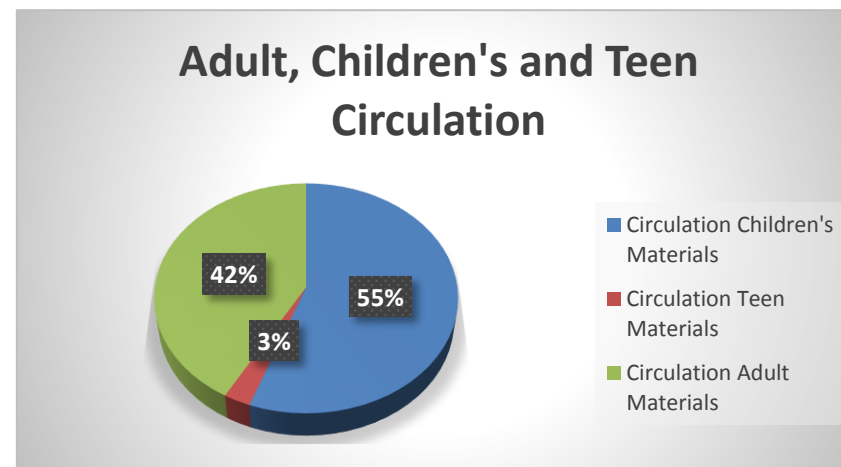
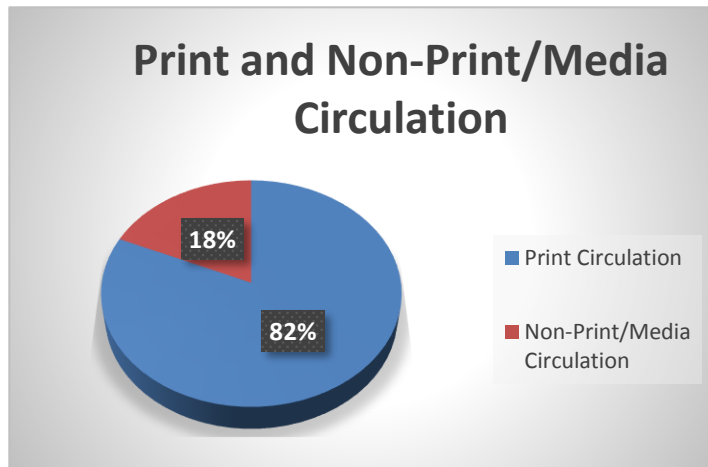
