Introduction

The Outdoor Learning and Experiences for Delaware Libraries was developed to create outdoor placemaking experiences at each Delaware Library tailored to community needs and conditions. The goal of this work is to develop outdoor and learning experiences based on Delaware Libraries' strategic areas of focus, customer needs, and community alignment.

The curriculum and programming guidelines were developed through a series of one-on-one conversations with 30 participating Delaware Library directors and also involved tours of 10 Delaware libraries. The conversations aimed to better understand each community, community needs, community conditions, and physical needs, challenges, and opportunities to design the ideal customer outdoor experiences at the libraries.

The Outdoor Learning and Experience guidelines creates the opportunity and place to utilize outdoor assets in the community and consider partnership opportunities. This work re-imagines how Delaware Library services aren't just about books and the building, but it is about providing access to positive customer experiences, meeting community needs, and bringing thoughtful experiences to community members.

These Outdoor Learning and Experience guidelines aim to surface concrete outdoor elements to bring the customer experience to life through exploring ways to address the need for access to digital and technology resources, and provide space for people of all ages to gather, learn, create, and share as communities experience and transition post-pandemic. The conversations also worked as a way to encourage the library to explore and expand the work the staff is already doing in the libraries.

The Outdoor Learning and Experience guidelines will enable Delaware Libraries to unify in a new way to create meaningful and positive user experiences in and out of the libraries for all in the community, and will inspire excitement, amazement, and curiosity throughout the county

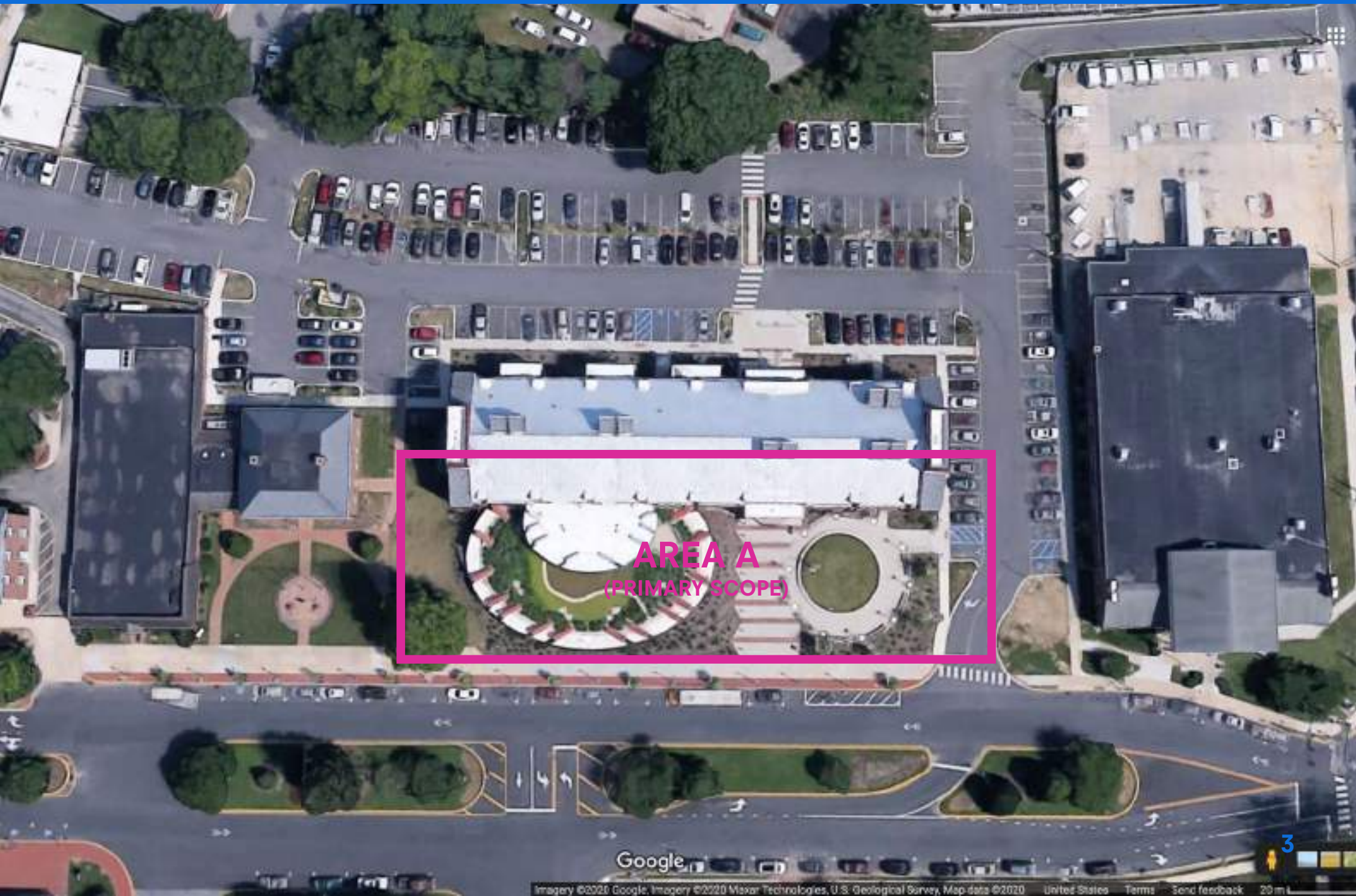

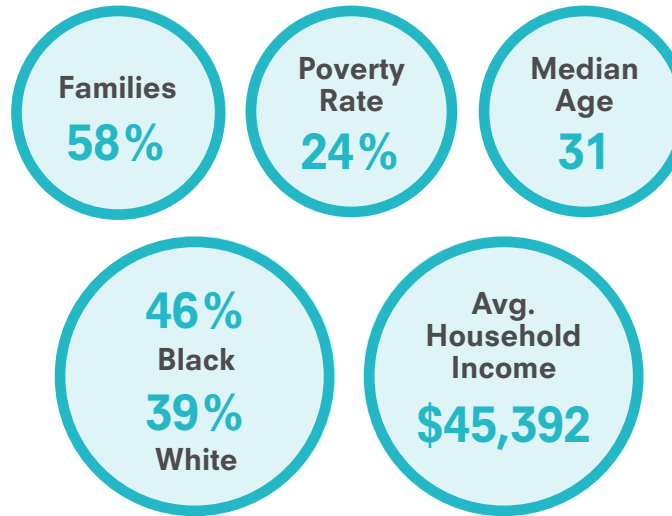
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



Dover Public Library service area has a population of 38,166 with a median age of 30. Currently, library users are predominantly teens, families, and seniors.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed the need to foster outdoor programming, the desire to implement solar energy, and the desire to support community needs around food insecurity. Ideas were generated to support these goals, which include activating outdoor spaces with art installations and offering intergenerational programs. Examples include outdoor maker spaces, local author festivals, live music, and yoga programs. Teens actively use this library, and an outdoor area dedicated for teen use would be ideal. The library discussed the potential opportunity to share outdoor space with the City Council building next door. Through partnerships, the library would also like to support workforce development and community food outreach and distribution. The MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Inclusion, Personal Development, and Literacy & Learning at the Dover Public Library.

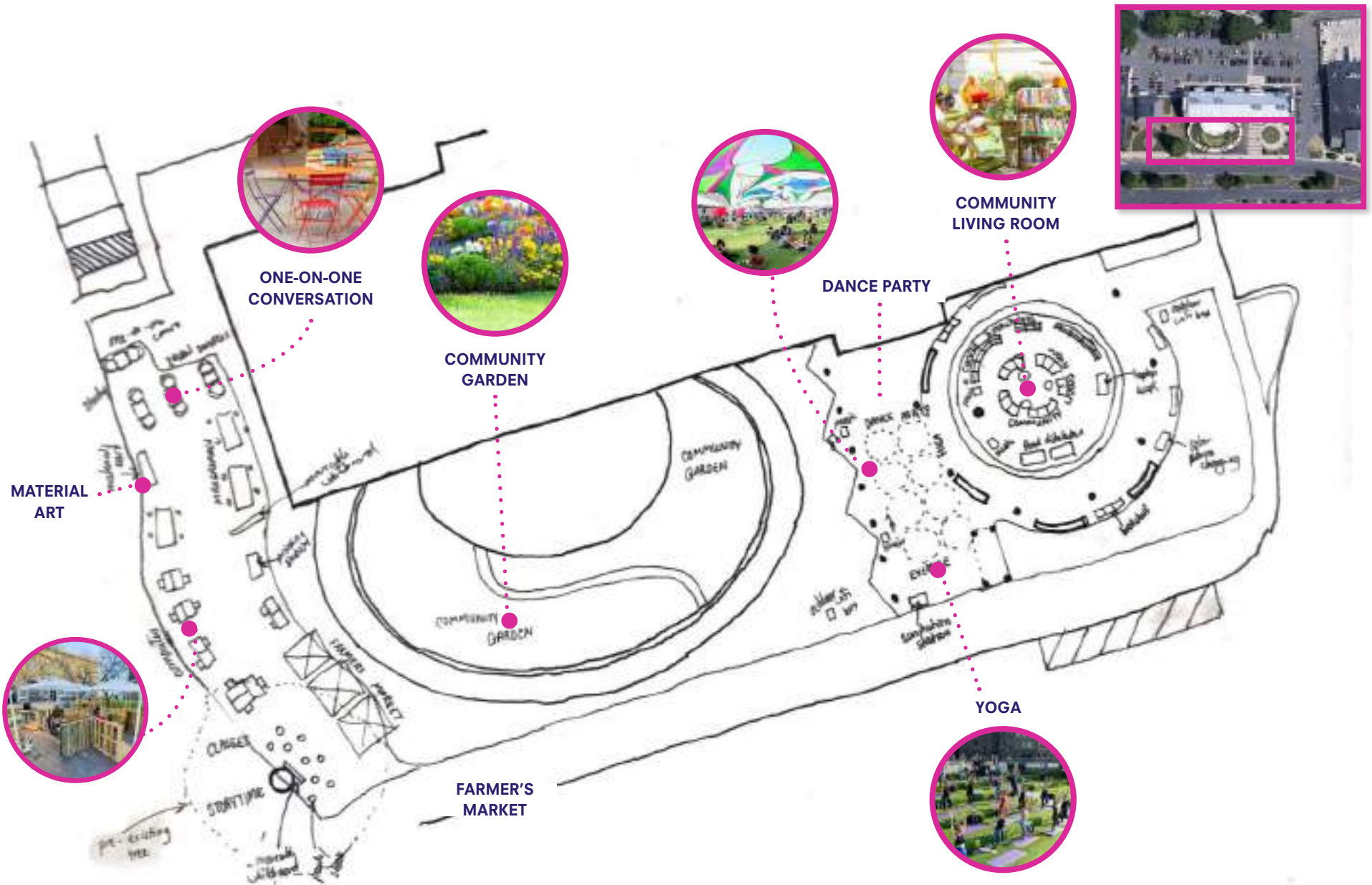

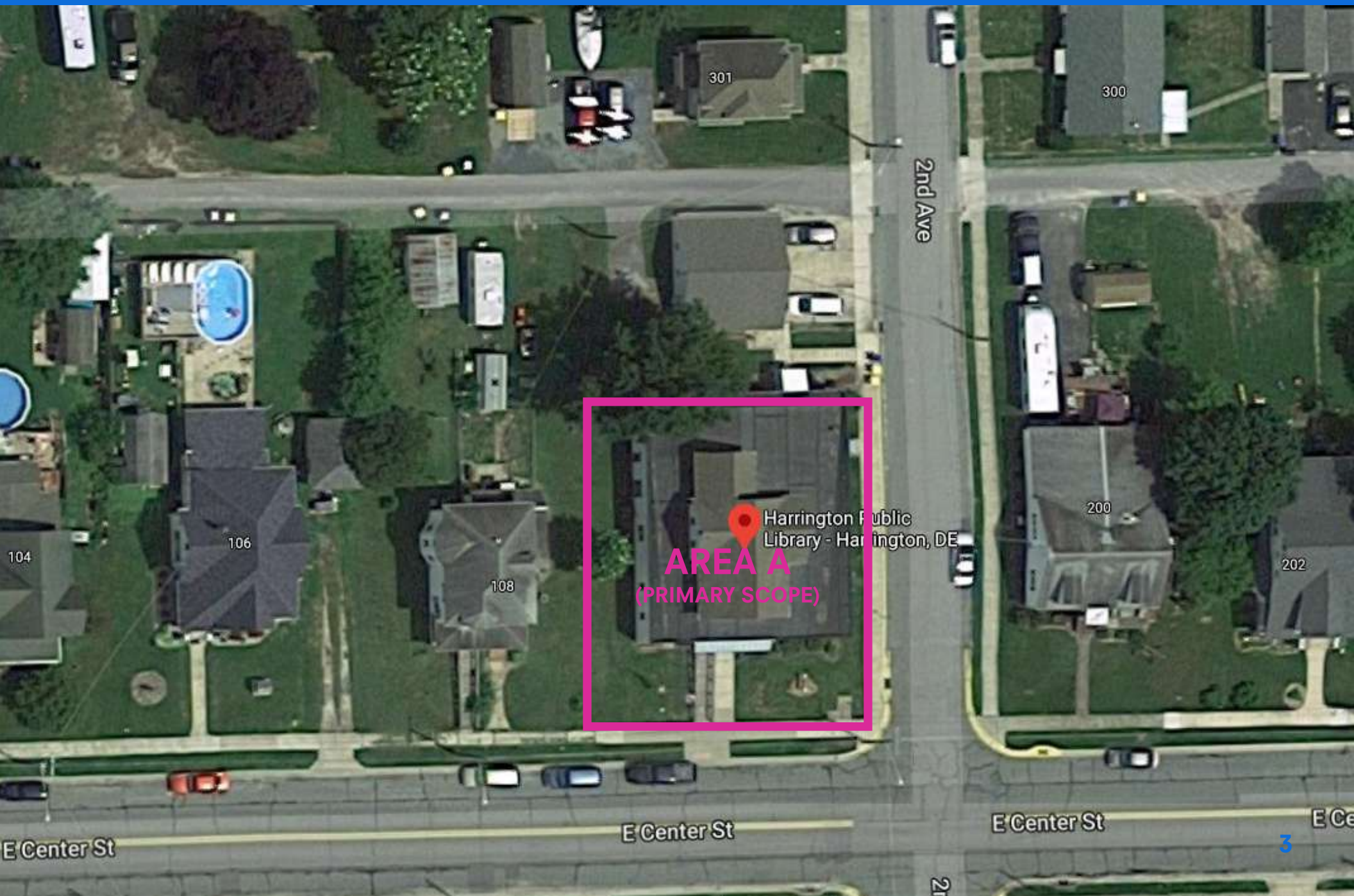

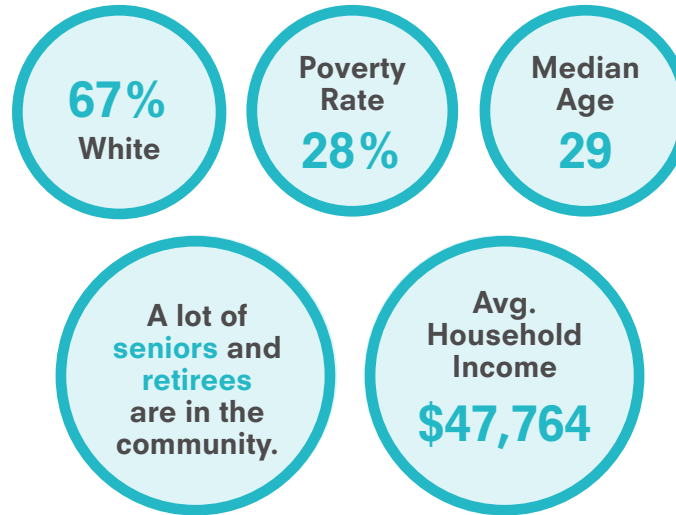
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



The Harrington Public Library service area has a population of 3,638 with a median age of 29. Harrington is an old railroad town that is small and diverse, primarily consisting of working-class families. Residents work at local casinos, fast food restaurants, and grocery stores; there is a need for new business development in the community to expand on skilled job offerings in the area.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed the need to support community access to computers and WiFi, and the desire to foster workforce development through programs helping community members in need of job search and resume-writing assistance. The Harrington Public Library would like to explore outdoor experiences that foster intergenerational gathering, possibly a space to foster the library's robust teen involvement, and explore ways to activate Little Freedom Park more through partnerships with the local police department and other community organizations. The MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Digital Literacy, Personal Development, and Inclusion at the Harrington Public Library.

DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS

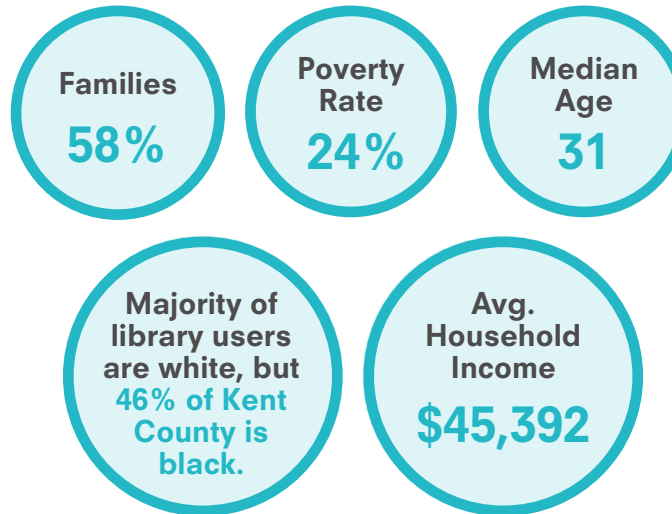


The Kent County Public Library service area has a population of 38,166 with a median age of 31. This library serves a small town, and the library itself is one of the smallest in Delaware.

Many Kent County residents live on a limited income, and seniors are the library's primary customers who love going to the library for craft programs. The library has a challenging time attracting diverse customers due to its location within a strip mall and lack of local transportation infrastructure. Bookmobile is another famous program in the library.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed the potential to activate outdoor experiences through the library's bookmobile sites. Arts programming is very popular, and one idea was that the library could sponsor an annual Central Delaware Festival for the Arts! The festival would highlight storytelling, dance performances, live music, and plant swaps. The library's WiFi hotspot and computer distribution is a high-use service in Kent County; Library customers also enjoy financial literacy programs and book and food club gatherings. The MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Lifelong Learning, Personal Development, and cultivating Entertainment and Inclusion at the Kent County Public Library.

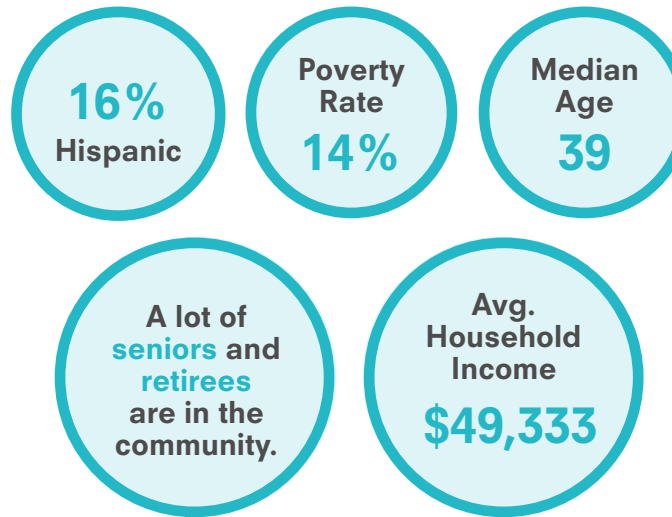
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



The Milford Public Library service area has a population of 11,732 with a median age of 39. Historically, Milford was a ship-building town; Today, ladybug-themed signage and emblems can be found throughout Milford because the community was responsible for petitioning for the identification of a state bug. Milford consists of people of all ages and a diverse community that includes people of Latinx and Haitian backgrounds. Library programs are well-attended from the Latinx community.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library identified current observations of community needs which include at least 500 customers a day requiring employment support and skills development training. Many patrons also go to the library for tax assistance. The library also wants to support the community need for access to computers, technology, and free public WiFi. Programs and services could be fostered through partnerships with local schools, organizations, and community-wide events that utilize the town's River Walk. The MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Digital Literacy, Literacy & Learning, promoting Inclusion, and developing Personal Achievement.

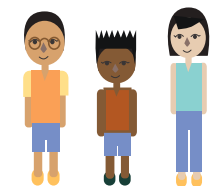

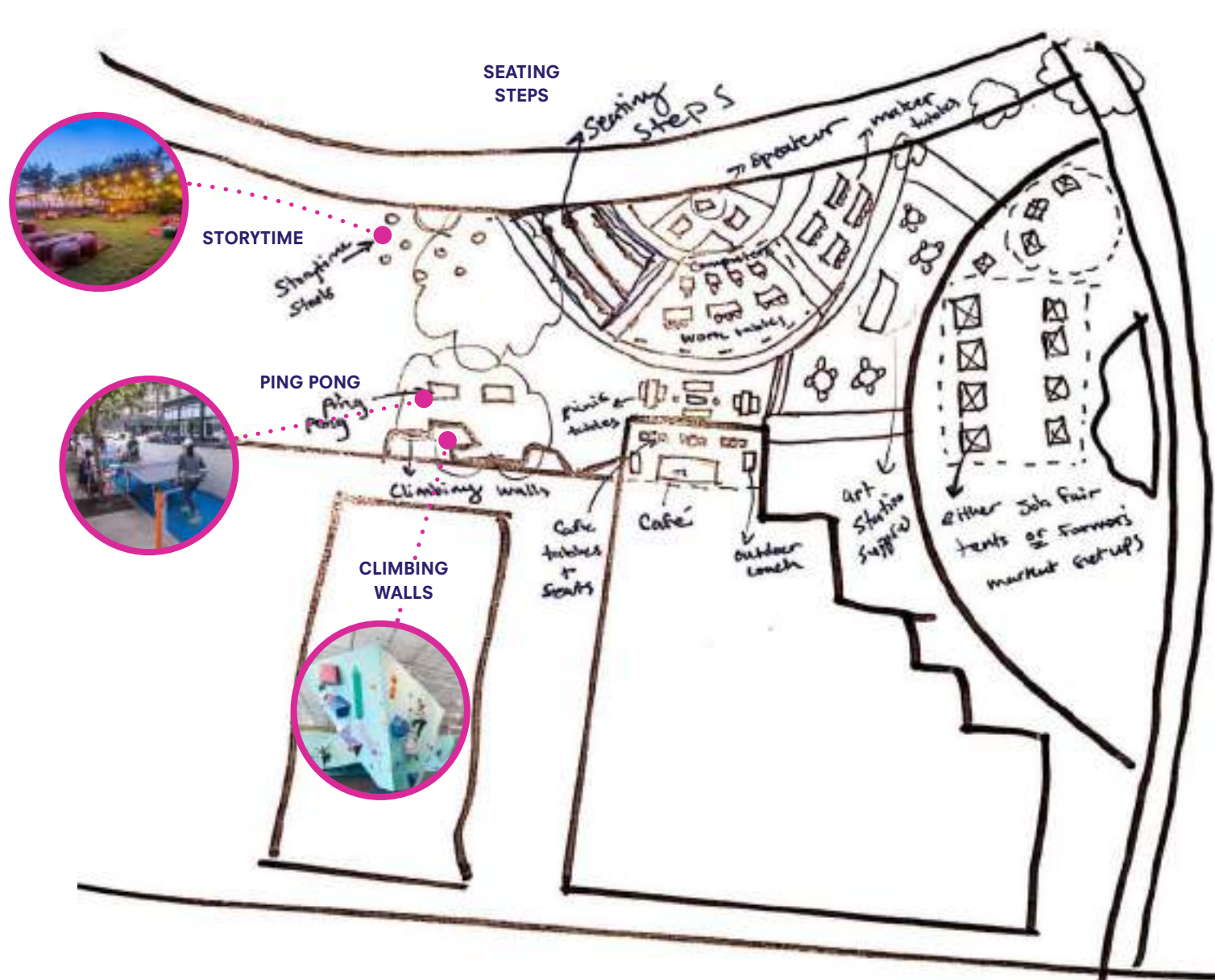

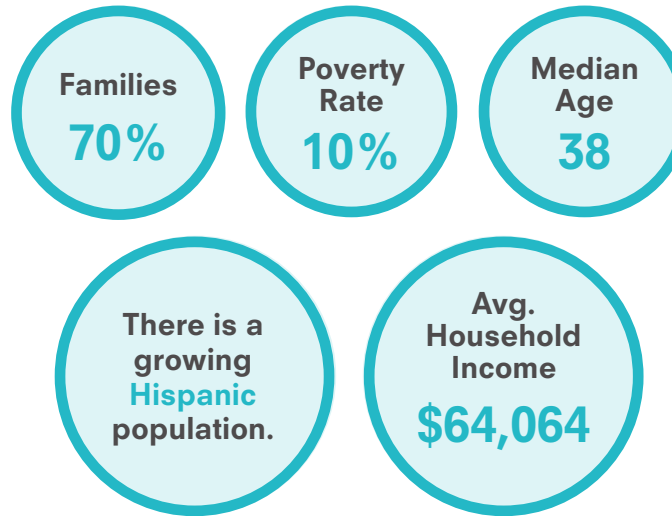
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



The Smyrna Public Library service area has a population of 11,813 with a median age of 38. The library is currently in a shared-use facility and occupies the 1st floor of the building, and the Opera House occupies the rest of the building. Seniors and young children are the primary library users. Smyrna is a small, passionate, and fast-growing community with an increase in the Latinx community moving to the area.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed the observation that many residents in the area are renters and that there is a high need for social services and access to computers and printing. Storytime and arts and crafts programs are well-attended. To activate the library's outdoor spaces, it would be ideal to have a fenced-in area to protect children from parking lot traffic. The MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Digital Literacy, cultivating Inclusion, and nurturing Personal Development.

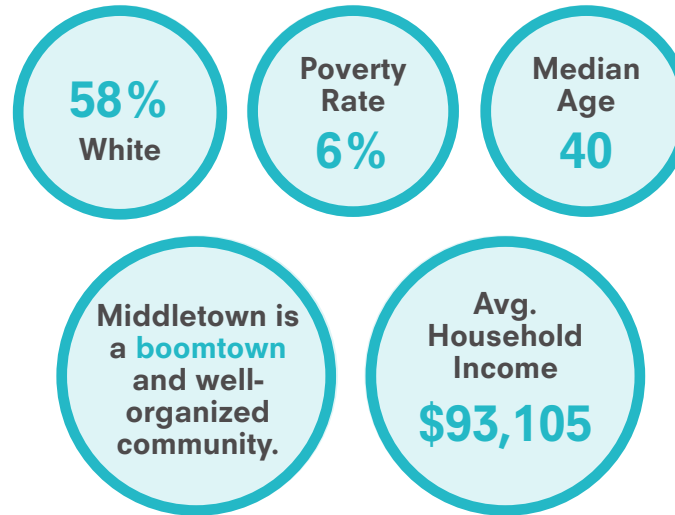
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



The Appoquinimink Community Library service area has a population of 22,900 with a median age of 40. Appoquinimink used to be a peach-growing town and has an annual Peach Festival every August. It is a well-organized and self-contained boomtown where people come from different parts of the country. Newcomers are mostly family-oriented and have children and teens in their household.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed ways they serve their community needs which include offering access to computers and materials that are primarily utilized by Appoquinimink's immigrant and senior populations. There is a need for more meeting spaces for town residents, particularly for teens who need a space to hang out and socialize. A new library facility is slated to open in early 2022. To support the library goals, the MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Literacy and Learning for All, Personal Achievement, and advancing Collaboration and Entertainment at Appoquinimink Community Library.

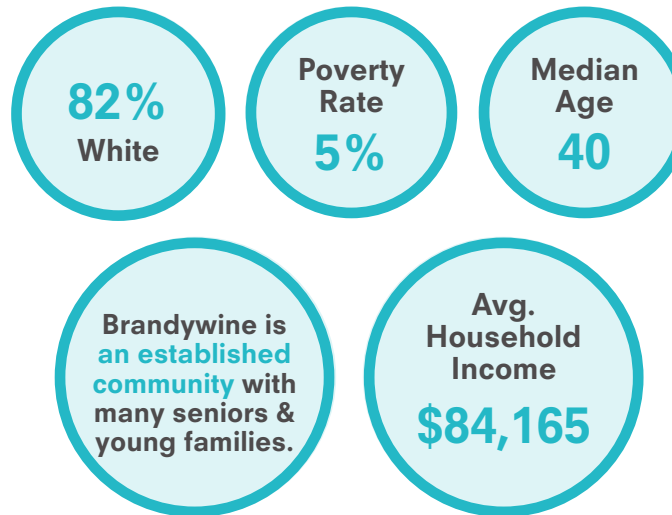
DEMOGRAPHIC SYNTHESIS



The Brandywine Hundred Library service area has a population of 82,672 with a median age of 40. The library is located in a very established middle-class community. Residents are active in their communities and mostly college-educated. Seniors and moms with their kids are the library's primary customers. Seniors love music performances and concert series that are held on the patio every summer, and moms usually come for storytime and children's programming. Delaware County runs a summer program that is popular among kids. This program offers various outdoor activities in the park, such as sports, reading, and rocket launching.

Through the design team's conversation with the Library Director, the library discussed the community need to foster access to technology. Access to WiFi on the property is needed and the library's colonnade requires electricity in order to offer laptop access outside. Most patrons come to the library to enrich their skills and hobbies, and popular programs include concerts, movie nights, Civil War-related, and outdoor activities. To support these goals, the MSS design team proposes activating outdoor experiences through Learning & Literacy and fostering Creativity and Entertainment at Brandywine Hundred Library.

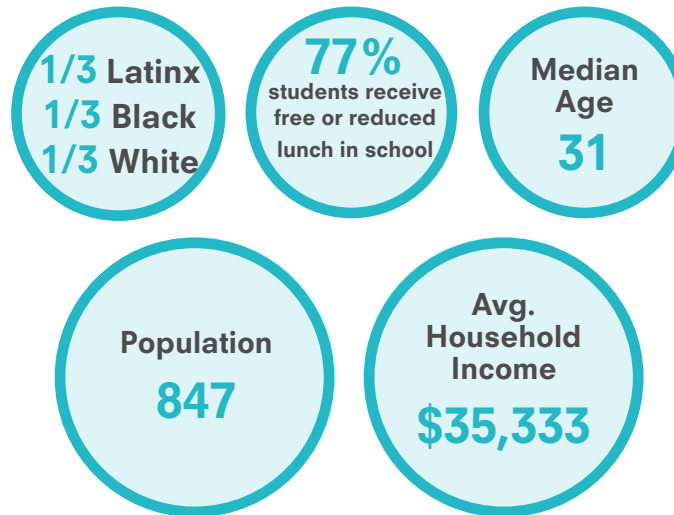


The Frankford Public Library has a population of 847 with a median age of 31. They serve a small community that is tight knit and heavily utilizes the library.
